Dear friends of Higher Ground:

Thank you for your prayers and gifts for Higher Ground Bible Ministry. Jefferson Gathu, the leader of our prison division, sends thanks for the Bibles we purchased with the offering you sent. There is a constant need for Bibles in the prison ministry.



There is strong momentum in the Kenyan prisons. In February, 800 officers attended a prayer breakfast at Naivasha Maximum Security Prison. During the first quarter of 2026 there were 35 conversions to Christ. During



the same time 25 officers enrolled in Higher Ground Bible courses, prison guards were converted to Christ, and 40 prisoners signed up for HGBM Bible courses. Upon completing the course work they will be qualified to assist the prison chaplains employed by the Kenya government. In addition, 10 HGBM students have been released and are in the process of being reintegrated into society. Many, if not most, will become involved in local church ministries. Some will likely enter the ministry full time, becoming pastors or evangelists. It is gratifying to know that your support of Higher Ground makes this possible. Praise the Lord!

I also have some news. After much prayer, Joyce and I have decided to move back to California. This will enable me to expand Higher Ground Bible Ministry. It will also allow new opportunities for my teaching ministry. We will be moving at the end of April. For now, please send your offerings to the Alaska mailing address. We ask you to pray for us during this transition. We will be living at Joyce's condo in Orange. I will notify you regarding a California mailing address.
